



## Migrating StoryBook Creator: XP to Vista, Windows 7

Below are the directions to move your memory vault(s) to an external hard drive and then to a different computer.

Find the location of the vault in Memory Manager 3.0

1. Be on the Welcome Page for your vault
2. Write down the location of the vault and use that location in the directions. The location will be in the parenthesis.

The following directions are written using the default path for a memory vault of C:\My Memory Vault. If your vault is in a different location, please use the path you wrote down from above.

### **Move a Memory Manager 3.0 vault from a Windows XP computer to a Vista or Windows 7 computer with an external hard drive**

1. Close Memory Manager and make sure the external hard drive is connected to the computer
2. Open the Start menu and go into My Computer
3. Open the C:\ drive
4. Right-click on My Memory Vault
5. Go to Send To and select the drive letter of the external hard drive (this will copy the vault to the external hard drive)
6. Safely disconnect the external hard drive from the first computer and connect it to the second computer
7. Make sure Memory Manager 3 is installed, activated and updated
8. Open the Start menu, select Computer, and open the external hard drive
9. Right-click on My Memory Vault and select Copy
10. Go the Start menu and select the user name (upper right-hand corner)
11. Right-click in a white area and select Paste (this will copy the vault into the user name folder)
12. Open Memory Manager 3
13. Click on Open Another Vault
14. Select More Memory Vaults on My Computer
15. Select the user name on the left-hand side so it is highlighted (right underneath Desktop)
16. Click on My Memory Vault on the right-hand side of the window
17. Click Open Selected Memory Vault
18. If the vault is correct, then you can delete the vault from the external hard drive and from the original computer

### **Move Creative Memories content to an external hard drive or to an external hard drive and new computer**

Finding the location of projects in StoryBook Creator:

1. Select Open an Existing Project in StoryBook Creator 3.0
2. Click on the "list" icon in the upper right corner (button with black lines)

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3. Expand the Path column by clicking on the column separator (just to the right of Path) and dragging the column to the right
4. Write down the path(s) and browse to the location of the folder(s) from your Windows Start menu

### Locating packages in SBC 3.0

Default locations are:

XP: C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Shared Documents\Creative Memories\Packages  
Vista/7: C:\Users\Public\Public Documents\Creative Memories\Packages

To find the location if they are not in the default location:

1. Select User Settings from the Welcome Page of StoryBook Creator
2. Select Content from the left-hand panel
3. Write down the specified path and browse to the location through the Windows Start Menu

### Move StoryBook Creator content and packages from a Windows XP computer to a Vista/7 computer with an external hard drive

1. Close StoryBook Creator 3.0 and make sure the external hard drive is connected to the computer
2. Go to the Start menu and select My Documents
3. Right-click on the Creative Memories folder
4. Go to Send To and select the drive letter for the external hard drive (this will copy the User Content, Projects, and StoryBooks (if you upgraded from 2.0) folders to the external hard drive)
5. Go to the Start menu and select My Computer
6. Go to C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Shared Documents\Creative Memories
7. Right-click on the Packages folder
8. Go to Send To and select the drive letter for the external hard drive (this will copy the Packages folder to the external hard drive)
9. Open StoryBook Creator 3.0
10. Go into Manage My Content
11. Click on Activation Codes and select 'Make backup copy of all my activation codes'
12. Click on File, choose Save As, and save this document on the external hard drive
13. Safely disconnect the external hard drive from the first computer and connect it to the second computer
14. Make sure StoryBook Creator 3.0 is installed, updated, and activated
15. Go to the Start menu, select Computer, and open the external hard drive
16. Right-click the Creative Memories folder and select Copy
17. Click on the Start menu button and select the user name (top right-hand corner)
18. Right-click in a white area and select Paste

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19. Click Yes when you receive the message "This destination already contains a folder named Creative Memories"
20. Go back into the external hard drive
21. Right-click on the Packages folder and select Copy
22. Go to the Start menu, select Computer and go to C:\Users\Public\Public Documents\Creative Memories
23. Right-click in a white area and select Paste
24. Click Yes when you receive the message "This destination already contains a folder named Packages"
25. Open StoryBook Creator 3.0
26. Click on Manage My Content and activate your packages again using the activation codes you saved to the external hard drive
27. Click on Open an Existing Project and select More Projects on My Computer
28. On the left-hand side, expand [your user name]\Creative Memories and click on Projects (and/or StoryBooks) so it is highlighted
29. Open the projects one-at-a-time (as you open them, they will show on the Recently Used Projects list)
30. You can now delete all of the content from the external hard drive and the original computer
